TRASH

CURBSIDE WEEKLY TRASH COLLECTION

Only trash placed within the Township issued trash containers will be collected by the township’s contractor. Missed collections are to be reported to REPUBLIC SERVICES (856) 234 – 4000.

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Bulk trash is collected weekly on your scheduled trash collection day.

Acceptable Bulk

- Covered Mattresses
- Nonferrous furniture
- Large toys too large for trash can
- Carpet rolled/tied in 4’ lengths

Unacceptable Bulk

- Trash bags
- Whole house cleanouts
- Construction debris
- Contractor Waste

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION SCHEDULE

March
April
May
June
July
August
September
October

Once crews pass a house, they will not be back again for pick up until the following scheduled month.

- Brush shall be placed at the curb by Monday 7:00am of your scheduled week but no sooner than 7 days prior.
- Do not cover utility caps with brush

Acceptable BRUSH

- Shrubs, bushes & tree pruning's

Unacceptable BRUSH

- Grass, flowers, weeds, stumps, leaves, lumber, fence sections, trimmings from a contractor

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

November
December
April

- Leaves should be placed at the curb by Monday 7:00am of your scheduled week but no sooner than 7 days prior.
- Do not cover utility caps with leaves

Acceptable LEAVES

- Neatly piled on curb strip or in brown recyclable leaf bags

Unacceptable LEAVES

- Leaves piled in the street more than 7 days prior to your scheduled collection week.
- Leaves in plastic bags, mixed with brush, mixed with trash

Brush & Leaves are collected by sections

Section 1 begins on the first full week of a month. (Full week = Monday – Friday)

LEAVES & BRUSH MUST BE IN SEPARATE PILES

Improper content & placement of yard debris is a violation of NJDEP Municipal Stormwater Regulations and Township Ordinances. Violators can be subject to notice of violation and/or court appearance.
