Pathways to Progress

Pathways to Progress is a request from State Legislature of local municipalities to support the recommendations of the Path to Progress report issued by the New Jersey Economic and Fiscal Policy Workgroup. The workgroup has made recommendations for pension and benefit reform, education reform and tax reform. Mayor McGill asks committee members to review the report to decide how to proceed with the outlined reform.

East Riverton Engineering Study

Mayor McGill explains that based upon recent public input, several months ago the Township Committee decided to examine some of the road and flooding issues in the East Riverton section of the Township. The Township met with several of our professional staff and completed a site inspection of the area and are close to finalizing a scope of study and proposal in this regard. Mr. Schubiger adds that they have had a couple meetings with Pennoni. He, Mr. Day and Mr. Marshall have been out to the neighborhood and met with some of the residents. He believes that we should have some answers within a few months. Mr. Horner states that he has discussed with Mr. Schubiger the idea of a subcommittee to review and communicate with the residents. Mr. Horner asks for committee's approval to appoint a subcommittee and invite the residents to meet with them. Committee approves.
