Special Meeting June 21, 2021

Meeting Minutes

Mayor Segrest announced that the Special Meeting of the Township Committee was being held in accordance with the "Open Public Meetings Act," P.L. 1975 c.231, having been duly noticed to the Burlington County Times and the Courier Post on June 8, 2021.

In attendance: Mr. Conda, Mr. Horner, Mr. McGill, Deputy Mayor Kravil, Mayor Segrest. Also present: Administrator Eric Schubiger, CFO Julia Edmondson, Municipal Clerk Lisa Passione; Christopher Norman, Solicitor, Kevin Gauntt, Superintendent of Public Works, Richard Calabrese, Chief of Police, Joseph Barbadoro, Remington & Vernick,

Mayor Segrest opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution 2021 – 96 Authorize Submission of Application to Green Acres for Improvements to East Riverton Park.

Presentation of proposed work at East Riverton Park was given by Joseph Barbadoro of Remington & Vernick. Mayor Segrest asked for verification of how much land was Township owned. Mr. Barbadoro confirmed the area. Potential parking spaces, lighting and various uses discussed by committee members.

Mr. Goins also commented on whether it would be a good idea to allow grills. Lastly he questioned about the repaving of all of the parks. Mr. Schubiger responded that we are always working to prioritize and keep all of our parks well maintained.

Lynn Wixted, 1306 Broadwood Avenue – Ms. Wixted asked about additional parking where the field usage and tennis court would be removed. Mr. Barbadoro replied that the parking will be maximized within the park.
