October 4, 2021

Meeting Minutes

Mayor Segrest announced that the Work Session Meeting of the Township Committee was being held at 6:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building at 1621 Riverton Road, Cinnaminson, NJ 08077. This meeting was held in accordance with the “Open Public Meetings Act,” P.L. 1975 c.231, having been duly noticed to the Burlington County Times and the Courier Post on January 8, 2021.

PRESENTATION

Public Service Electric & Gas – Vegetation Management Work – Supervisor Michael Kozlowski
They are performing their 4-year maintenance vegetation management in their right of way lines that run through Cinnaminson. Property owners were notified 20 days ago as required. Work will begin October 14th at the earliest, weather permitting. Anything over 20 feet in the wire zone has to come down. They believe the project will last about three weeks.
