Public Works – Mr. Segrest

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has rehabilitated a confined disposal facility (CDF) adjacent to the Delaware River behind Inman Street, Kern Street and Zeisner Avenue. The CDF is being used to contain dredged materials from the Delaware River. To date, all dredging has been completed however the contractor has stated that a buyer for the dredged materials has been found. The material will be hauled once the buyer has received their permits from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, which is anticipated to be issued in March 2023. An updated schedule will be provided once the hauling operations begin. That concludes my report.


