RESOLUTION 2023 – 132

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF CINNAMINSON TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11 authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing Agreement for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the County of Bergen, hereinafter referred to as "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2023, the governing body of the Township of Cinnaminson, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

TITLE: This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Township of Cinnaminson.

AUTHORITY: Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5), the Township Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.

CONTRACTING UNIT: The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with provision of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO CANCEL TAXES PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION FOR A TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN
