October 15, 2024 - Voter Registration Deadline for General Election

October 23, 2024 - Mailing of Sample Ballots for General Election

October 26 - November 3, 2024 - Early Voting Period

October 29, 2024 - Deadline to apply for a Mail-In Ballot by Mail for General Election

November 1, 2024 - Deadline for Application to Receive General Election Mail-In Ballots by Electronic Means for Qualified Overseas Civilian and Military Voters

November 4, 2024 by 3:00PM - Deadline for In-Person Mail-In Ballot Applications for General Election

November 5, 2024

- General Election Day - Polls are open from 6:00AM until 8:00PM.
- Deadline for Post Office Receipt of Mail-In Ballots from the General Election
- 8:00PM Deadline for Delivery of Mail-In Ballots at a Secure Ballot Drop Box

November 7, 2024 - Deadline for Receipt of Timely Mailed Postmarked Mail-In Ballots to the County Board of Elections

## Track My Ballot

### How To Track the Progress of Your Ballot

Start by signing into your personal My Voter Record account.

If you do not already have a My Voter Record account, you will need to set up an account.

### Ballot Tracker Status Descriptions

A voter's ballot status on the Tracker will be updated by each individual county. The amount of time it takes until updates are posted to the Track My Ballot tool will vary from county to county. Please check back periodically for updates to your ballot status.

**Displayed Description**

**N/A** Your ballot has not yet been received by your county's Board of Elections.

**Received** Your ballot has been received by your county's Board of Elections. The security envelope it was mailed in will be checked to make sure it has been signed. The signature will then be reviewed and compared to make sure that it matches the signature in your voting record.

After your ballot is checked it will either be cleared for counting or rejected (see below)

A voter's ballot status on the Tracker will be updated to "Received" by each individual county. The amount of time it takes until updates are posted to the Track My Ballot tool will vary from county to county. Please check back periodically for updates to your ballot status.

**Rejected** Ballots can be rejected for a number of reasons, the most prevalent being a missing or non-matching signature. A missing or non-matching signature is the only reason, by law, that a ballot can be 'cured' and then counted.

If your vote by mail ballot was missing your signature or the County Board of Elections has determined that your signature does not match the signature in your voting record, your county Board of Elections will provide you an opportunity to certify that you did, in fact, cast that ballot. That process takes the form of an email, phone call or letter to you from the County Board of Elections that will give you the opportunity to certify that you are voting.

A voter's ballot status on the Tracker will be updated to "Rejected" by each individual county. The amount of time it takes until updates are posted to the Track My Ballot tool will vary from county to county. Please check back periodically for updates to your ballot status.

**Accepted** Certifies that your ballot has been counted.

A voter's ballot status on the Tracker will be updated to "Accepted" by each individual county. The amount of time it takes until updates are posted to the Track My Ballot tool will vary from county to county. Please check back periodically for updates to your ballot status.
