**Route 130, Bridge over Pompeston Creek
Cinnaminson Township, Burlington County
July 30, 2025 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM**

The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT), committed to developing transportation solutions that best balance transportation needs, the environment, community concerns and cost, will hold a Public Information Center (PIC) to provide local residents and businesses with information on the **Route 130, Bridge over Pompeston Creek** project. You will have an opportunity to review exhibits of the project, ask questions and discuss any concerns with NJDOT representatives. BACKGROUND

The purpose of this project is to improve the condition of the Route 130 bridge over Pompeston Creek.

EXISTING CONDITIONS

The Route 130 bridge over Pompeston Creek, located at milepost 37.84 in Cinnaminson Township, Burlington County, has been identified as in need of full structure replacement. The bridge was originally constructed in 1925 and was widened on the southbound side in 1934. It is 27 feet long and 112 feet wide, carrying three lanes of Route 130 traffic in each direction. The bridge is categorized as being in fair condition.

Route 130 features three travel lanes in each direction and a posted speed limit of 50 mph. The bridge is located on a horizontal curve, with signalized intersections approximately one-quarter mile to the north and south. In the project area, Route 130 is bordered by Lakeview Memorial Cemetery on the northbound side and several businesses on the southbound side. Additionally,

there is a small dam in Pompeston Creek to the east of the bridge, creating a small lake within Lakeview Memorial Cemetery.

THE PROPOSED PROJECT

The project proposes a complete bridge replacement to improve the condition of the structure. Sidewalks are proposed on both sides of Route 130 within the project limits. The proposed bridge cross section includes three 12-foot-wide lanes in each direction with 10-foot-wide inside and outside shoulders. The existing bridge span length will be maintained. Two stormwater basins are proposed along the southbound side of Route 130.

During construction, three lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Route 130 to minimize disruptions. It is anticipated that the bridge will be replaced in four major construction stages with no long-term detours. Sidewalks will remain accessible during construction.

Right-of-way acquisitions will be necessary to accommodate the bridge and approach roadway widening, as well as the stormwater basins. Utility facilities will be relocated with service maintained during construction.
